Galley / Saloon

The TrawlerCat 48 galley and saloon are bright, beautiful, modern and have all the conveniences of home.



This elegant galley boasts an island bar with stainless steel twin sinks with hot and cold water mixer, propane stove, combination microwave/convection oven, well insulated side-by-side front-loading refrigerator/freezers, a separate ice maker and a water purification system. All this is standard equipment on the TrawlerCat 48. Making most of the things people would want as standard equipment is an Endeavour tradition.



The TrawlerCat 48 actually has two identical refrigerator/freezer units standing side by side. In the left picture above, the second refrigerator/freezer is blocked from view by the door of the first one. The picture on the right is of the standard ice maker and the optional wine chiller.

This galley is open to the saloon and keeps anyone on kitchen duty right in the middle of all the activities. For those of you used to having a wide open kitchen, this arrangement will make you feel right at home.



The seating arrangement in the saloon is flexible and can be tailored to the owner's personal tastes and needs. Shown here is a wraparound sofa with one or more free-standing chairs. A hide-a-bed convertible could easily be used here. The flooring is the popular and beautiful bamboo.



On the starboard side of the saloon and galley is the flat screen TV, the main entry and exit door and the stairway leading up to the SkyLounge.

SkyLounge / Steering Station

Up a flight of stairs, you'll enter yet another huge room that can seat another dozen or more people.

This comfortable room is fully climate controlled by its own dedicated central heat and air conditioning system, whether at the dock or underway. There are three large windows forward, very large opening windows on each side, and rear sliding doors, so visibility is excellent in all directions and the breezes flow through unimpeded.





The steering station is located in the SkyLounge and will keep you completely out of the weather, no matter how bad it gets. You'll stay warm all winter or cool all summer.



The steering station is laid out for safety and convenience. All controls are right at hand. There's ample space for any instrument you could ever want, even the popular large-screen radars and chart plotters.

There's a large comfortable sofa located right next to the steering station with the same panoramic view, so your guests can join you while you're underway and enjoy the scenery.

From the steering station, you can see the side door which gives direct access to the deck. Should you need to go out on the deck in a hurry, you are never more than a few steps away.





Master Suite / Staterooms

The Master Suite is located on the upper level, just forward of the pilothouse. It has a queen-size island berth with full-size end tables on each side, two hanging closets, and a chest of drawers. The large windows flood the room with natural light and the two forward hatches let the breezes flow in while the screens keep the bugs out. The master suite's private head features a huge Roman-style shower. The photo below is looking aft into the head and down the hallway to the saloon with the full-length mirror in between.



The guest suite is located in the port hull. In addition to the queen-size bed, drawers and hanging closet, this suite has a complete head with full shower and dressing area. Opening ports with screens let the breezes flow through and the 12-volt fans keep the air moving even when the air outside is still. Of course, when it gets too hot or cold, the quiet and efficient central heat and air conditioning system ensures your guests' comfort.



The third stateroom is located on the starboard side of the main level and features two single berths with plenty of storage space in the form of drawers and hanging lockers. The large window opens to keep this stateroom bright and well ventilated.

The guest head is comparably equipped with oval sinks, Gibraltar counter tops and high-polish, stainless-steel fixtures, and of course, another shower stall.

How's This for Engine Access !





Both engine rooms are accessed through the floor of the saloon. There is plenty of room for even the big guys to comfortably perform regular maintenance. You've got easy access to anything on the engine. The engines are the legendary Yanmar turbo diesels producing 380 hp each. Plenty of power to propel this yacht at 16 knots, yet economical enough to take you over 2,500 miles at a comfortable 7 or 8 knots. The optional engine upgrade is the 440 hp Yanmar turbo.
